

There's another unique thing about India: a lot of its collective knowledge exists in "shruti"(in voice) and "smruti"(in memory) as centuries of invaders destroyed its written knowledge and manuscripts. This method even allowed the Upanishads to survive over time. For centuries, this knowledge has been practised as living traditions, weaved into the daily lives of billions. The physicist Ervin Schrödinger, who worked on the nature of reality and is known for his Schrödinger's cat experiment, reportedly carried a translation of the Upanishads and revered its core insights about the nature of apparent duality. Indeed, its unique views on self-knowledge, the nature of reality and consciousness can help chart a new way of thinking about safe AI as we race towards the so-called 'AGI'.

#### The 3 Stages Of Al Development

There are three stages that mark the learning and development of AI.

Stage 1 is learning from freely available data on the internet, which resulted in ChatGPT and other such systems powered by LLMs. It has become useful in creating text and solving other problems, though it's still not alarmingly influential.

Stage 2 is about creating AI agents, that research, co-work

with and co-learn from human feedback. It's here that India, with a population of 1.4 billion brought up on a rich diversity of thought and action, can play a big role. We are expected to get to some aspects of AGI at this stage.

Stage 3 is all about learning and augmenting from the physical and digital world. This is going to be tricky and critical, and we will have to be careful about what AI ends up learning, because it will soon power 40-50% of the workflow in real-life situations. It's this stage that will truly power a man-machine society of 7.5 billion humans working with more than 30 billion intelligent machines. Unlike human beings, biases in AI technology can grow exponentially, and in a much shorter span of time, humbling creators if they are not careful. India Must Take The Lead

The US, with its powerful internet and social media giants driven by profits, may end up creating a path to AI that puts profit ahead of humanity. China, which is prone to imprinting its central leader's thinking onto algorithms to exact control, may power a future where AI might rule over human beings. Both scenarios are not sustainable. On the other hand, India, with its rich, sustainable, civilisational history, has the potential to shape a future where humans can realise their full potential, together with AI.

Sam Altman might have been wrong about India's potential contribution, but he was spot-on about the inadequate resources we are putting into becoming an Al force to reckon with at a global level. The India AI mission is a great start, but we need to double down with a sizable private capital pool and AI compute resources that can support our talented technologists and researchers. We need to enable them at warp speed to digitize and mine the rich civilizational knowledge India possesses for building AI. Otherwise, our kids may not like the 'Matrix' future we may leave for them. Maybe it's time for India to take the 'Red Pill' and stomach this unsettling reality that we are undoubtedly hurtling towards.

# **Presenting Gulzar, A Poet Who Embraced Quantum Mechanics Like No Other**



Writing in the Times Literary Supplement in October 1921, English poet and critic Thomas Stearns Eliot remembered John Donne thus: "Tennyson and Browning are poets, and they think, but they do not feel their thought as immediately as the odour of a rose. A thought to Donne was an experience; it modified his sensibility."

Eliot's assessment of Donne was true of some others too whom Samuel Johnson had in the eighteenth century called the the-extinct "race" of metaphysical poets. Not incidentally, however, the crown of thinking-as-experience is also befitting for Indian poet, lyricist, author, and filmmaker, the Sahitya, Oscar and Jnanpith awardee, Sampooran Singh Kalra, better known by his takhallus (pen name), 'Gulzar'.

# New Zealand woman jailed after 53kg 'severely overfed' pet dog's death

The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals described Nuggi as "one of the most obese animals we've ever encountered." The dog was so overweight that it could barely walk and suffered from severe health complications.

(News Agency)-A woman in New Zealand has been sentenced to two months in prison after her severely obese dog died. The dog, named Nuggi, weighed a staggering 53 kg when rescued by authorities in 2021.

According to a Newsweek report, the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) said Nuggi was in such a critical condition that it could barely walk 10 metres without stopping to catch his breath. Its legs were visibly buckling under his immense weight.

The dog was removed from his owner's home, where multiple dogs were found, and placed in the care of the SPCA. 

## **Bella Hadid breaks silence** over Adidas ad row, says lacked sensitivity

The Adidas campaign, which featured the SL 72 "coveted classic" sneakers from the '70s, coincided with the 52nd anniversary of the Munich Olympics, where 12 Israeli coaches and athletes were killed by Palestinian terrorists.

After Adidas launched the campaign, the American Jewish Committee tweeted against the Adidas campaign.

Adidas then apologised and even removed all tweets featuring Hadid from their X and Instagram handles.

BELLA HADID RESPONDED TO THE UPROAR ON INSTAGRAM Supermodel Bella Hadid took to Instagram Stories to express her "disappointment in the lack of sensitivity that went into the campaign". "I am shocked, I am upset, and I am disappointed in the lack of sensitivity that went into this campaign. Had I been made aware, from the bottom of my heart, I would never have participated," Hadid wrote

on her Instagram story on July 29. She explained that she had no prior knowledge of the historical connection to the 1972 events before the campaign's release.

"I would never knowingly engage with any art or work that is linked to a horrific tragedy of any kind. In advance of the campaign's release, I had no knowledge of the historical connection to the atrocious events in 1972," Bella wrote.

Supermodel Hadid admitted that both her team and Adidas should have conducted more research to avoid such a situation.

"While everyone's intentions were to make something positive and bring people together through art, the collective lack of understanding from all parties undermined the process. I do not believe in hate in any form, including antisemitism. That will never waiver, and I stand by that statement to the fullest extent," she stated.

The supermodel also criticised the idea that Palestine is linked to terrorism, rejecting the connection between "the liberation of the Palestinian people" and the antisemitic attack.

Hadid calls herself a "proud Palestinian" and has been vocal in her support for Gaza in the Israel-Hamas war. She had even marched against former President Donald Trump's decision to recognise Jerusalem as Israel's capital.

"Palestine is not synonymous with terrorism and this campaign unintentionally highlighted an event that does not represent who we are. I am a proud Palestinian woman and there is so much more to our culture than the things that have been equated over the past week," Hadid wrote on her Instagram story.

I will forever stand by my people of Palestine while continuing to advocate for a world free of antisemitism. Antisemitism has no place in the liberation of the Palestinian people. I will always stand for peace over violence, any day. Hate has no place here, and I will forever advocate for not only my people, but every person world wide," she added.





# Ruth Vanita On Love's Rite, Gender, Sexuality, And A Slight Angle



## How Israel killed Palestinian commander Wadie Haddad with toothpaste in 1978

## By Ananya Bhattacharya

It was an uneventful mid-January day in 1978 in Baghdad when Wadie Haddad began suffering from severe abdominal spasms after a regular meal. Haddad was the chief of the Palestinian organisation, Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine. His appetite was gone. He lost more than 25 pounds, and was taken to an Iraqi government hospital. The doctors there diagnosed him with hepatitis. They followed by saying it was a case of a very bad cold. Powerful antibiotics were administered. Haddad was treated by the best of Baghdad doctors. But his condition did not improve. The needle of suspicion pointed at poisoning, but what or how, the doctors had no clue. Yasser Arafat, the leader of the Palestine Liberation Organisation, asked an aide to get help from the Stasi, East Germany's Secret Service. This was a time when the Soviets helped the Palestinian fighters and provided them with passports, shelter, weapons and intelligence. When Arafat's aide reached out to the East German Secret Service, or the Stasi, Haddad was moved from Baghdad to East Berlin. He was admitted to a hospital where they treated intelligence and secret-service community members. It was March 19, 1978. By now, Haddad had spent
